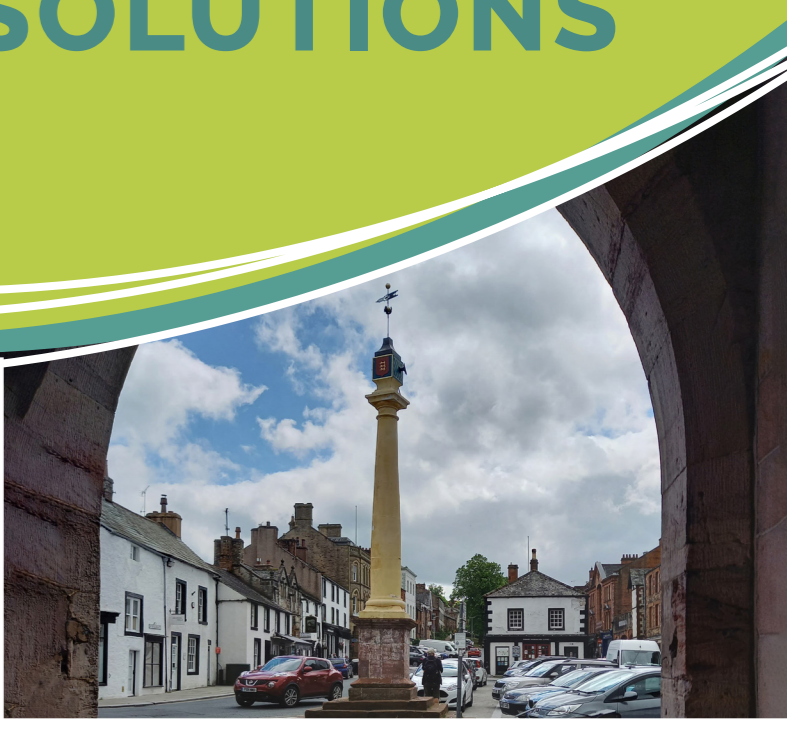

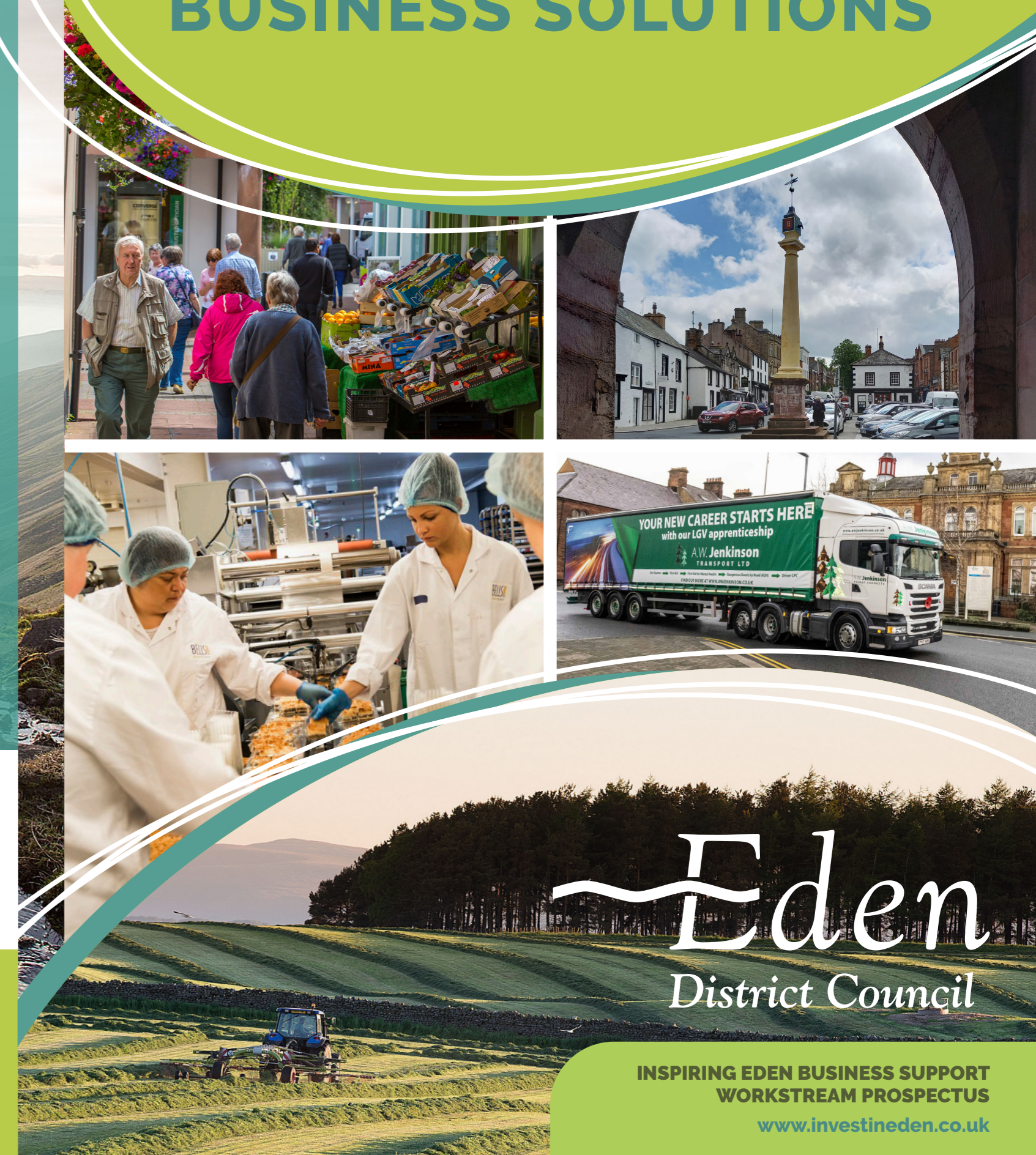

WHAT WE OFFER

Our Economic Development team offers a range of services that can be tailored to meet the needs of local businesses. Businesses can be assured of a personal service and you will be allocated a named contact within the team who will listen and signpost businesses to appropriate support and advice.

The current key services our team provide are:

Free business advice and signposting to sources of information and funding

Eden District Council offer 1:1 business support and advice. Our advisors are able to have an informal, confidential discussion with you to talk about your business challenges and opportunities and provide help, advice and point you in the right direction to a range of advice and support provided by our partner organisations.

Sector specific advice

Our team is able to offer sector specific guidance. Our tourism team work closely with tourism businesses across the district advising on a range of key areas including set-up, legislation and promotion. www.visiteden.co.uk is a destination website designed to attract visitors and promote tourism businesses. The Eden Visitor Guide is printed annually with a print run of 40,000 that are distributed nationally through a range of literature distribution channels.

Greening Eden for Business Initiative

Through this project, funded by Eden District Council, managed and delivered by the CBEN Partnership, participating businesses will be offered the opportunity to have their carbon footprint, the commonly accepted metric for assessing the environmental impact of a business, calculated. For most organisations, the largest emissions will be from use of mains gas, LPG & transport fuel (Scope 1 emissions) and grid electricity (Scope 2 emissions). Larger organisations will be encouraged to look at emissions from their supply chain (Scope 3 emissions). The CBEN Partnership will complete the calculations using data provided by businesses and site visits to provide practical and cost-effective advice on how to reduce emissions. These could range from no-cost changes in behaviour, low-cost actions, or capital investment projects that deliver substantial emission reductions. Where capital investment projects are identified and agreed, the level of grant support available from the Greening Eden capital grant fund will be agreed prior to work commencing.

Access to grants via Eden Apprenticeship Scheme

Eden District Council offers financial support to local businesses who are taking on new apprentices in Eden. Companies are offered a grant of up to £2,000 towards wage costs for each new Apprenticeship.

Free membership of a local business support network

Eden District Council can offer businesses the opportunity to sign up for free to a range of business support organisations in the region. We also offer membership of the Eden Tourism Network, which is a free support and information network for businesses based in the visitor economy.

Access to support young people into employment via Eden Youth Hub

Eden jobseekers under the age of 25 are able to access extra support in their search for work through the Eden Youth Hub. Based in the Eden Foyer in Penrith, with outreach locations across the District, the Hub delivered by Inspira on behalf of Eden District Council and their partners, links young people with employers. It is part of the UK Government's multi-billion-pound Plan for Jobs. Young people will be encouraged to take part in new initiatives including Dragons Apprentice Challenge which encourages people to develop a range of enterprise and entrepreneurship skills

Access to Eden business loan scheme

Eden District Council has partnered with Enterprise Answers, a Community Development Finance Institution, each contributing £250,000 to create a £500,000 pot of money which local businesses can apply to support their growth and development plans.

Businesses applying for a loan would be expected to demonstrate through a business plan how they intend to grow, develop and upskill their workforce. The fund can provide loans of between £10,000 and £150,000 with repayment terms of up to 10 years. Unregulated lending solutions of £10,000+ are available for Limited Companies and £25,001+ are available for Sole Traders and Partnerships.
